DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

God has a knack of showing up in impossible situations just in time and revealing His nature in the midst of them. When has God shown up in an impossible situation in your life? What did you learn about God from it?

Why do you think God let Moses see the Promised Land before he died even if he wasn't going to be allowed to enter it? What does this tell you about God?

When are the times or situations that you are likely to lose your patience with other people? Does this reveal anything about your own heart?

We learned that Moses deviated from God's instructions in three specific ways: (1) he judged the people ("you rebels"); (2) he put himself in the place of God ("must *we* bring water"); and (3) he tried to speed along God's ways (he hit the rock). Which one of these three behaviors do you struggle with the most? Why?

The main lesson we learned on Mount Nebo was this: *We can't both serve God and want to be God.* Where specifically are you tempted to be God rather than *serve* God?
