DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Reread Micah 3:9-12. The people of God probably never could have imagined a day when the Temple in Jerusalem would have ever been destroyed, and it is a good reminder that even the things we think are most secure can still be brought to nothing. Where are you tempted to put your misplaced hope in something or someone?

As you have participated in *otPANORAMIC*, are there specific areas where God has convicted you of sin in your life? How are you responding to God's conviction?

Reread Micah 7:18-20. What specific attribute of God's character do you need to be reminded of right now in your life? Why?

How has studying the big picture of the Old Testament had the biggest impact in your life? Be as specific as you can in answering this question.



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
