DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

You heard about the dramatic ways in which God delivered the people from captivity in Egypt, such as the 10 plagues and the crossing of the Red Sea. Why do you think God's deliverance was so dramatic? What do you think the people were learning?

Reread Exodus 19:4-6 and 1 Peter 2:9-10. We are told that because of our relationship with God we are (1) a chosen people, (2) a royal priesthood and holy nation, and (3) God's special possession. Which of these do you most need to be reminded of in your life? Why?

God was careful to remind the Israelites on Mount Sinai that He rescued them before He asked for their obedience. However, it is easy to begin to think that we have to get our lives right before God will rescue us. Why is this order—rescue then obedience—so important for us to remember?

How has this session changed or deepened your understanding of God? Be specific.

Reading the laws in the Old Testament can sometimes be confusing and difficult for us now. How has this session helped you understand why the law was given and why we should read it?
